Board Policy - Painting of Homes

Proposed Board Policy:

Board members met with the A & L Committee to establish a painting policy that is sensitive to diversity, for the Montage at Mission Hills community. The intent is to maintain the variations in colors from home to home along each street. After a very long and detailed discussion, the following policy was agreed upon and adopted:

- Any proposed variance in exterior paint requires the approval of the A & L Committee. A variance request must be submitted prior to any work being done.
- Colors must be chosen from the existing (original) color scheme assigned by architectural style, as follows:
 - A Italianate color schemes 1 3
 - C Tuscan color schemes 4 6
 - D Contemporary color schemes 7 9
- A homeowner may request changing the color scheme of their home to one of the other color schemes within their architectural style group.
- A homeowner may request elimination of one of the colors in the architectural style group pallet (e. g. the dark color that fades faster than the other colors).
- All painting must have professional appearance with the use of high quality paint
- Any existing paint variations due to builder and previous approvals are grand-fathered as of February 4, 2006.

The A & L Committee will maintain color pallets for each scheme. It was agreed that we will attempt to reproduce color pallets for each homeowner.
